Autoimmune type 1 diabetes (T1D) starts in the body

long before there are any visible signs or symptoms. Typically, T1D is only diagnosed after symptoms appear, when a person is unable to make enough insulin and potentially life-threatening complications, like diabetic ketoacidosis (DKA), can happen without warning.

The attack on beta cells starts long before people develop symptoms and need insulin injections. **The** early (or pre-insulin dependent) stages of type 1 diabetes are when 2 or more diabetes-related autoantibodies are found in the blood. Screening with a blood test using a finger stick or blood draw can help detect autoimmune type 1 diabetes early.
